



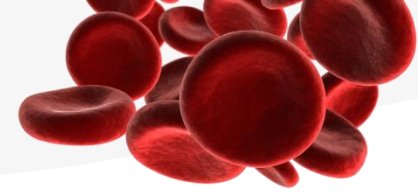

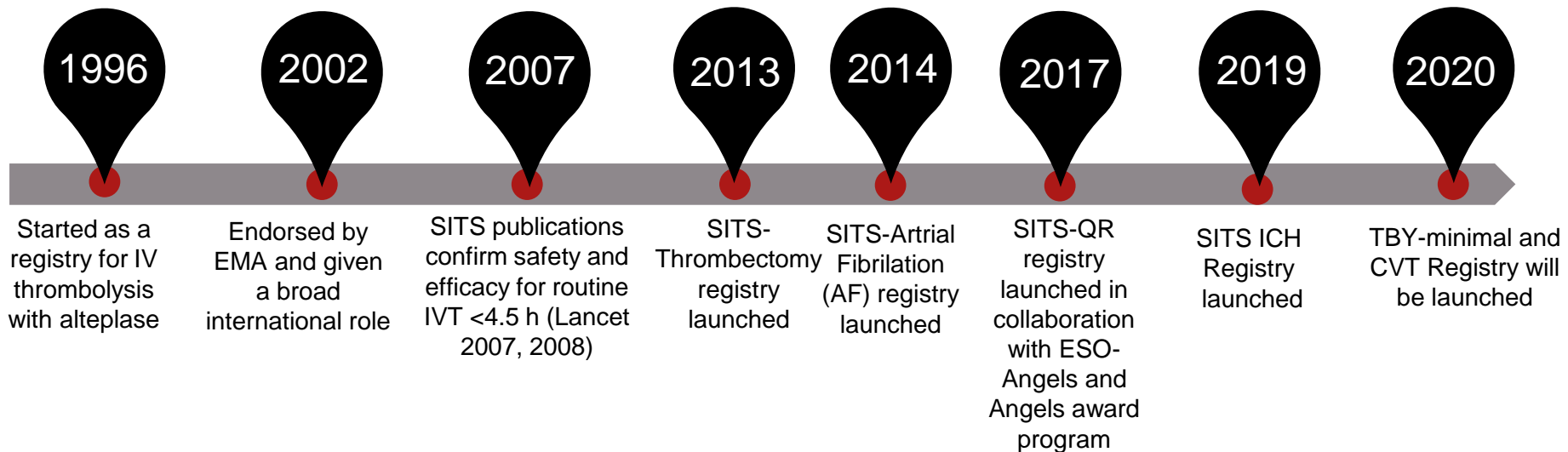
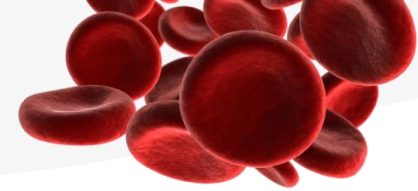


SITS is:

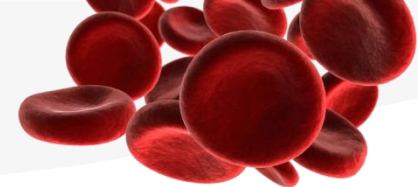


- A research driven, non-profit foundation

Impact on stroke treatment guidelines

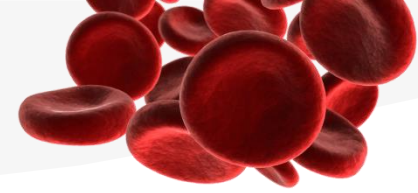
- Introduction of IVT in Europe (0-3.0 hours)
- Extension of the treatment time window (3-4.5 hours)
- Treatment in the elderly
- Patients with diabetes & previous stroke
- Patients on Warfarin, LMWH
- Patients with very severe stroke (NIHSS >25)



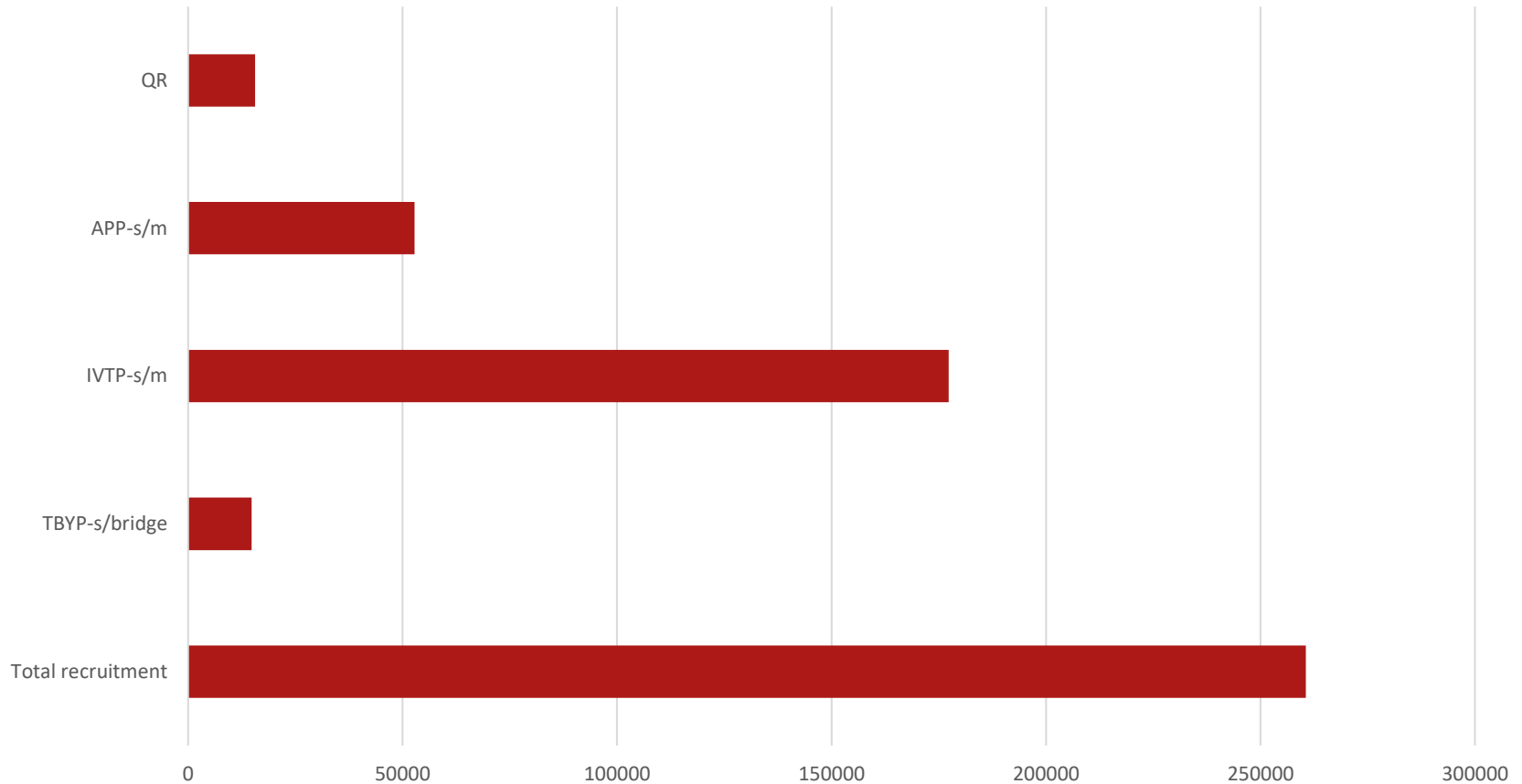
Cumulative patient recruitment in SITS



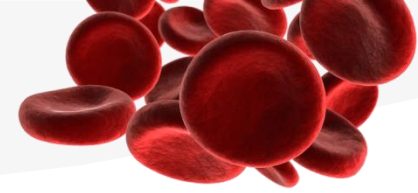
Total patient recruitment 2003-2019 by protocol

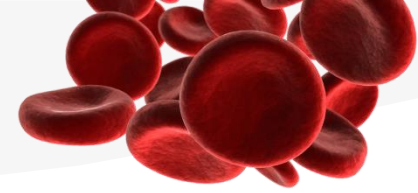

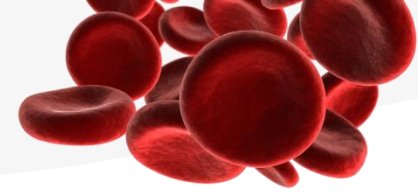

- A new **centre** is created, to which the registrant becomes **Local Coordinator**

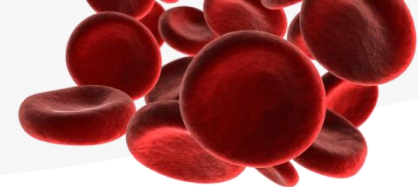

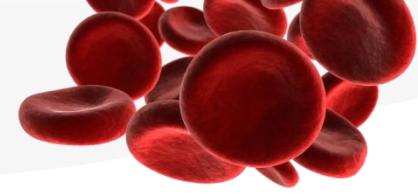
